The resolution to establish the World Tsunami Awareness Day was adopted by consensus at the United Nations General Assembly in December 2015. This resolution was jointly proposed by 142 countries for raising awareness of the risk of tsunami and improving measures against tsunami.

Japan will host the High School Students Summit on World Tsunami Awareness Day for the first time in Kuroshio-town, Kochi prefecture as part of the educational activities on World Tsunami Awareness Day. High school students from 30 countries will participate in the Summit for discussions and presentations about disaster risk reduction. This summit aims at teaching the risk of tsunamis, which is common issue to be addressed by many countries, and sharing knowledge about disaster risk reduction to train future leaders who can minimize the risk impact of damages by tsunamis.
